Shore Fishing Guide



1-Rainbow Park T-Dock



Dates to fish- Mid April-mid May

Target fish- Crappie, Perch, Whitebass

Presentation- Bobber, hook and split shot. Use small shiner or fathead minnows. Set depth between 2-5ft from the hook to the bobber. Fish between shore and the dock itself. Let the bobber drift along the dock.



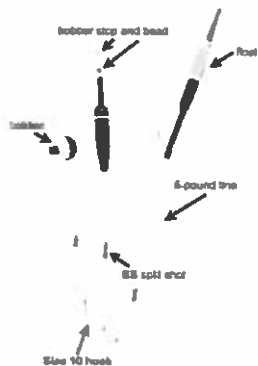
2-Sawyer Creek (Rochlin Park)



Dates to fish- Mid April-mid June

Target fish- Perch, panfish

Presentation- Bobber, hook and split shot. Use small shiner ,fathead minnow or worm. Set depth between 1-2ft from the hook to the bobber. Make sure bait is off of bottom. Fish from the bridge to the river.



3-Fishing Pier



Dates to fish- Mid April-mid July

Target fish- Whitebass, Walleye, Catfish

Presentation- River rig with a minnow or nightcrawler. Use a heavy enough sinker to hold bottom so rig does not slip in the river current. Cast towards the middle of the river or down current from the pier.

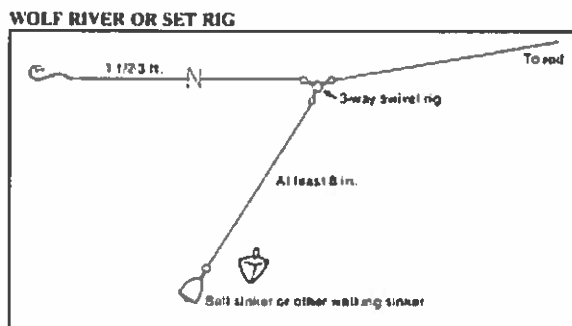

4-Bowen Street Dock



Dates to fish- Mid April-mid July

Target fish- Whitebass, Walleye, Catfish

Presentation- River rig with a minnow or nightcrawler. Use a heavy enough sinker to hold bottom so rig does not slip in the river current. Cast towards the middle of the river or down current from the dock.

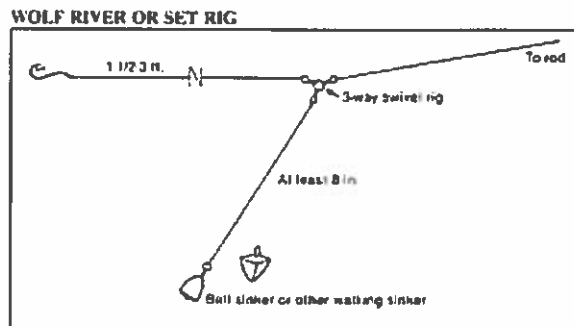

5- 24th St Boat Launch



Dates to fish- July-August

Target fish- Northern Pike

Presentation- Cast a Mepps 3 spinner in the channel from the railroad bridge to the lake. Be sure to use a Snap Swivel so your line does not get twisted.



6- Miller's Bay (Menominee Park)



Dates to fish- Mid May-August (Weeds must be present)

Target fish- Bass, Walleye, Panfish and Perch

Presentation- Bobber set 1-2ft deep with a worm for Panfish. Small spinner or 1/4oz Cleo for Walleyes and Bass. Fish from the boat launch north along the shore and the dock pictured above. Be sure to use a snap swivel if using the spinner or Cleo to prevent line twist.



7- South Asylum Bay



Dates to fish- Early May-End of June (Weeds must be present)

Target fish- Panfish

Presentation- Bobber set 1-2ft deep with a worm or small minnow. Fish from the boat launch west. Cast near weeds.
